## **Upper Arlington Issues** (Note: UAPA doesn't take a stand on local issues.)

### **Issue 51**

Upper Arlington Public Schools 5.8-mill operating levy request. It would generate about \$9.2 million per calendar year for the district and would meet its operating needs for three years. The levy would cost homeowners an additional \$178 in annual taxes.

### **Issue 24**

It will determine if new businesses in the city's community entertainment district (CED) can obtain liquor licenses. Also determines if businesses that already have liquor licenses can keep them.
